WHERE TO PICK UP AND DROP OFF: Centennial Park Teen Room.

CAMP HOURS: Mon-Fri 10:00 am-4:00 pm

All campers must arrive at the site no later than 10:00 Am., unless otherwise notified. Buses depart promptly and many trips are scheduled to leave shortly after 10:00am. Day camp activities are scheduled until 4:00 and most days campers will not return from their daily adventures until that time.

- **EXTENDED CARE:** 7:00-10:00 am and 4:00-6:00 pm
Extended care hours for campers are provided at all sites. The cost of extended care is included in the weekly camp fees.
- **NO LATER THAN 6:00 PM:** Please ensure that your child is picked up by 6:00 pm. The YMCA is required to charge \$1.00 per minute for every minute after 6:00 pm that your child remains in our care.

SIGN IN AND OUT: Please be sure to sign your child in and out everyday & always verbally tell a staff member when your child is coming and or going. This will help us ensure their safety at all times. We ask that parents **DO NOT** pick up children at field trips due to safety issues. It is imperative that we know at all times when your child is with us, and we rely on you to help us by signing them in and out every day.

DAILY TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Campers will usually travel to and from their daily adventures via Paso Robles Public Schools Transportation Service and Lucia Mar Public Schools Transportation Service. We may also use the city/county transportation system.

CAMP ESSENTIALS

Everyday your child should bring a backpack with their belongings, plenty of water (preferably in a canteen or thermos), sunscreen, and a lunch (we provide a morning and afternoon snack). On swim days they should also bring along a towel and swim suit.

- **Lunches** need to be healthy and not require heating. There is no refrigeration or heating available.
- **WATER ONLY PLEASE** Soda is not allowed at camp for dehydration reasons. Dehydration is the leading cause of illness during camp because of the extreme temperatures.

CAMP T-SHIRT MUST BE WORN ON ALL FIELD TRIPS For safety reasons it is imperative that your child wear the YMCA's Camp T-shirt on all Field Trips. This allows us to quickly identify children that are in our care.

CAMP TIPS
